

Annual Listing of Federal Obligations

2016

The 2016 Annual Obligation Report for the Benton-Franklin Council of Government's Regional Transportation Improvement Program lists the projects for which Federal transportation funds have been obligated in the Benton-Franklin region during the calendar year 2016.

Transportation Improvement Program

Per 23 CFR 450.332:

In the MPO area, on an annual basis, no later than 90 calendar days, following the end of the program year, the State, public transportation operators and the MPO shall develop a listing of projects. The listing shall be prepared in accordance with 23 CFR 450.314(a) [agreement on the responsibilities for the development of the annual listing of obligated projects and shall include:

- * All federally funded projects authorized or revised to increase obligations in the past year.
- * At a minimum include the TIP information under 23 CFR 450.324(e)(1) [for each project or phase - sufficient descriptive material (i.e., type of work, termini and length) to identify the project or phase].
- * 23 CFR 450.324(e)(4) [lead agency for the project or phase].
- * Identify for each project the amount of federal funds requested in the TIP.
- * The federal funding that was obligated during the preceding year, and
- * The federal funding remaining and available for subsequent years.
- * The listing shall be published in accordance with your MPO's public transportation criteria for the TIP (e.g., the internet).
