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The following URBAN amendment(s) are requested for May 2017:

URBAN Large

Richland, Duportail Bridge

STIP ID# R002; Adding STBG funding of \$789,449. Construct a 4-lane road and bridge over the Yakima River with sidewalks and bike paths on both sides. Construct new signalized intersections at Duportail St./Tanglewood Drive and Duportail St./City View Drive. Install new water lines and utilities across the new bridge structure

Kennewick, Kennewick Pavement Preservation

STIP ID# kenn46; Adding STBG funding of \$1,600,000. Infrastructure preservation on city arterials: Union Street, 10th to 27th; 27th Avenue, Ely to Olympia; Columbia Drive, Kent to Fruitland.

Kennewick, West 10th Avenue Widening – Joliet St. to Columbia Center Blvd.

STIP ID# kenn9; Adding STBG funding of \$1,279,335.

Widening south side of the 10th Avenue. Bike lane, curb, gutter, illumination, sidewalk, center turn-lane and HMA overlay of existing.

Kennewick, Metaline Avenue Reconstruction – Kellogg to Edison

STIP ID# kenn20; Adding STBG funding of \$1,275,875. Reconstruction and widening. Curb, gutter, sidewalk, storm drainage and illumination.

WSDOT - SC, Region Wide Basic Safety - Signing

STIP ID #50000803; Adding \$146,400 of funding to new project. Replace existing deteriorating signs. This project updates signing at various locations throughout the region to address worn and/or nonreflective signing, and may also update sign posts. This work improves sign visibility for the traveling public. This record is for the Benton and Franklin counties portion of a region wide project.

TAP - Urban Large

Richland, Columbia Park Trail - East

STIP ID# R010; Adding TAP funding of \$403,623. Reconstruct the street to provide 3-lanes, with curb, gutter, sidewalks, bike lanes street lights, drainage facilities and streetscape on both sides.

URBAN – Rural

Benton County, Sellards Road, Phase II

STIP ID# BCO2015-21; Adding STBG funding of \$1,941,500.

Surface and road side rehabilitation.

TAP – Rural

Benton County, Badger Mountain – Candy Mountain Connector Pathway

STIP ID# WA-09854; Adding TAP funding of \$107,614. The project will construct a new multimodal pathway along Dallas Road between the Badger Mountain trailhead (approx. 3.19) and the new Candy Mountain trailhead (approx. 3.49).
